Frequently Asked Questions

- All submitted proposals should be <u>evaluation-focused</u>; proposals should speak to the challenges and lessons learned, or the methodologies and tools administered, in your evaluation experience(s) and not merely presenting study results. Proposals should <u>not be commercially-focused</u> to promote specific companies, products, and/or services.
- Proposal abstracts should be well-written and specific, as attendees will depend on the abstracts to decide which presentations to attend.
- Equipment/Technology: The presentation room will be equipped with a white board, projector, and computer. Internet access will also be available to presenters. Additional equipment may be supplied by the presenters or requested from SEA.
- <u>If your proposal is accepted</u>, you will be requested to review your presentation's listing and to confirm your intent to present. Once complete, you and any co-presenters should register for the Annual Workshop. While there is no discount for presenters, SEA strives to maintain low registration fees for all attendees.
