Description: Human papillomavirus (HPV) is the most common sexually transmitted infection in the United States and is responsible for nearly 26,000 new cases of cancer each year. Although uptake in HPV vaccination among adolescents has increased in recent years, Florida continues to lag behind the Healthy People 2020 goal for HPV vaccination. Learn how the Florida Department of Health in Duval County successfully collaborated with key stakeholders to develop, implement, and evaluate a community-specific action plan to increase HPV vaccination rates.

Speaker: Kristina Wilson, Ph.D. is the Director of the Office of Performance Improvement at the Florida Department of Health in Duval County. She earned her doctoral degree in Social Psychology at Colorado State University, where she specialized in attitudes, persuasion, and health behavior change. As the Director of the Office of Performance Improvement, Dr. Wilson oversees Community Health Improvement Planning, Strategic Planning, Quality Improvement, and evaluation activities at the Florida Department of Health in Duval County.
