### **A Few Statistical Concepts Everyone Should Know**

**Description:** This SEA Program will present a non-technical, practical explanation of selected statistical topics including averages, measures of dispersion and margin of error. Concepts will be illustrated using simple data sets and calculations will be shown and explained.

**Speaker: Daniel R. Thompson** currently serves as a statistician in the Florida Department of Health's Division of Public Health Statistics and Performance Management and develops statistical features for the Department's web-based health statistics portal, FLHealthCHARTS (Community Health Assessment Resource Tool Set). While Dan started his career in data analysis as a timber estimator in Georgia in 1975, he has applied his statistical expertise as a computer programmer, systems analyst, and epidemiologist in the public health field, particularly in the development of the Florida infant and prenatal risk screenings and analysis of infant mortality risk factors. He has a bachelor's degree in Forestry from Virginia Tech and a Master's in Public Health from the University of South Florida and is an Accredited Professional Statistician.
